**Most Universities and polytechnics offer a range of services and activities, for example:**

### **Student health**

- medical centre
- dentist
- counselling services
- gym / recreation centre

### **Student services and advice**

- Disability Services
- Student Learning Centre
- Library
- Student Job Search
- Services for Māori, Pacific Island, and international students
- financial or budgeting advice, scholarships office
- careers advice
- student accommodation
- car parking, discounts on public transport

### **Organised groups and events**

- Student Union
- social groups and clubs
- cultural groups
- religious groups
- political groups
- sports teams and events
- occasional free lectures, concerts and performances

### **Shops and services**

- student bookshop / stationery shop

  - hair salons staffed by student hairdressers
